## There is to be NO SALE OF CEREMONIAL PIPES, TOBACCO, INDIAN MASCOT TEAM CLOTHING, OR ALCOHOL.

- \* No selling of feathers from birds of prey.
- \* Security will NOT be provided each night after the event. Exhibitors leave their work at their own risk.
- \* Booths MUST remain open during the Powwow.
- \* Vendors are responsible for their own sales, taxes, and permits (if required).

Food Vendors: for information about Yavapai County Health Department Requirements, go to https://yavapaiaz.gov/chs/Forms/PID/5262/CategoryID/802/CategoryName/Special-Events

- \* Exhibitors are prohibited from distributing literature of or promoting any religious, fraternal, political, or commercial organization. Literature regarding the artist or craft person's work or gallery affiliation is permitted.
- \* NO RESALE ITEMS. All items must be handcrafted by the artist (VENDOR). Factory produced designs on ready-to-wear apparel are considered to be "resale" and are not permitted.
- \* A portable fire extinguisher is strongly recommended for each booth.
- \* If you need power, bring a generator to insure that you have power available.
- \* Arts and craft vendors will not be allowed to sell food or drinks from their booth.
- \* Please do not bring your pets with you.
- \* Open fires/flames are not allowed on the grass areas. If you have a tipi or tent, bring it and camp out!! Bathrooms and showers available onsite.
